
# What is the Adolescent and Youth Coaching (CAYC) Course all about?

The Objectives of the LSCC CAYC are to provide robust coach training and business development for coaches of adolescents and young people. By the end of the training, you will be able to:

- Identify the 8 ICF coaching competencies.
- Practice application of the 8 ICF coaching competencies
- Apply professional coaching skills
- Design a coaching business
- Demonstrate awareness of adolescent psycho-social development.

# LSCC Adolescent and Youth coaching Model

Our training model is based on three core concepts - Person, Skills and Principles



# Program design

The program comprises 74.5 coaching hours in three modules as follows:

- 1. Becoming a coach: Foundational skills and concepts
- 2. Coaching Practicum: Practical skills
- 3. The Business of Coaching

These are delivered as follows:

- 62.5 hours of live/synchronous learning and practice on a virtual learning platform, including 5 hours of observed coaching, and 7.5 hours group mentor coaching.
- 8 hours of asynchronous learning (self-directed study on learning management system).
- 3 hours of individual mentor coaching.
- 1 hour of organisations developmental planning

The program lasts 7 months and includes practice and role play as well as case studies.

Participants receive an e-workbook, access to the learning management system and credentials to log into the live sessions.

Why should you invest in coaching certification?

The ICF Global Coaching Study (2023) indicates that individuals and organizations expect their coaches to be certified and credentialed. Coach certification is therefore becoming increasingly important. 85% of respondents opted for accredited programs in the 2023 study, up from 69% in 2015.

- 3. Capacity to access online live sessions and asynchronous materials

## **Continuous Coach Education Units (CCEUs)**

If you are taking this course **before** it receives ICF Level-1 Accreditation (part of the accreditation requirements is to graduate some students first) you can still apply for your ICF ACC credential using the Portfolio Path.

The ACC - Portfolio path supports ACC applicants whose coaching education includes Continuing Coach Education (CCE) courses or coaching education courses that are not accredited by the ICF. ACC - Portfolio applicants are required to submit robust documentation of their coach education, such as program curriculum, with their application to demonstrate alignment with ICF standards. ACC - Portfolio applicants will also submit their mentor coaching and recorded coaching session for the performance evaluation with the application, along with the program certificate(s) and coaching experience hours (ICF, 2023). LSCC will provide necessary documentation and support for this process.

You may choose to receive your certificate post accreditation in which case you can apply using the Level 1-ACTP path.

# **Certification requirements**

To qualify for the certificate participants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Participation is required for at least 24/28 of synchronous sessions (be present and active for at least 80% of the session). Listen-only participation will count as 50% participation.
- 2. Provide a Coaching log 10 hours with at least 1 client.
- 3. Participate in Mentor coaching: 7.5 hours group mentor coaching, and 3 hours individual mentor coaching.

- 4. Provide one recording of a coaching session 20-40 minutes which should be assessed as 'pass'.
- 5. Write a reflective essay, 800-1200 words, on 'The Ethics of Coaching Adolescents'.
- 6. Complete readings in the LMS.

If you opt out of assignments you get a Certificate of Attendance, not a Adolescent and Youth Coaching certification.
